5. Parent and Student Handbook

- a) To foster more communication between the school and parents, an electronic version of the Parent Handbook has been created to help parents understand the information provided by the school. Parents can view the Parent Handbook in the School Information section of the E-class Parent mobile app.
- b) Please read the content carefully and sign the student handbook (p.2). Class teachers will collect the student handbooks on 6 September (Friday) for school chop stamping.

6. Other fees (Appendix I)

a) Special Purpose Fees

With the consent of the Parent-Teacher Association and the Incorporated Management Committee, the school will collect a Special Purpose Fee of \$360, which will be used for improving educational facilities, learning resources, and the school environment. For S1 to S5, the fees will be divided into two installments, with the first installment of \$180 payable at the beginning of the school year, and the second installment of \$180 payable in the second semester (the payment date will be determined later). S6 students only need to pay one installment of \$180. Students who have received Full Grant of School Textbook Assistance and Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) can apply for a waiver of the second installment of the Special Purpose Fee after the second semester. Details will be announced later.

b) Lesson Fees

With the approval of the Education Bureau and the Incorporated Management Committee, students in S4 to S6 are required to pay an annual Lesson Fees of \$340, divided into two installments. The first installment of \$170 is payable at the beginning of the school year and the second installment of \$170 is payable in the second semester (the payment dates will be announced later).

c) School Group Personal Accident Insurance Plan

To protect students from expenses incurred due to accidents during school activities or on their way to school, the school, with the consent of the Parent-Teacher Association, has purchased School Group Personal Accident Insurance for all students. Students are required to pay a premium of \$17 this school year. For details on coverage and compensation, please refer to pages 12-13 of the Student Handbook.

d) Notebooks and Other Miscellaneous Fees

Notebooks and other miscellaneous fees will be collected through autopay.
