Please be informed of the following school matters:

1. Distribution of First Term Report Cards

The First Term Examinations for Secondary 1 to Secondary 5 were completed on 21 January. The First Term Report Cards will be distributed during class teacher period on **27 February**. We ask that you carefully review your child's results with them to address areas for improvement and encourage continued academic progress.

Please sign the report card and keep it in a safe place for future further education applications. For Form 6 students, report cards will be issued alongside graduation certificates at the Graduation Ceremony on 23rd May.

3. Parent Survey – ‘LaC Study Tour to Malaysia’

To enhance students' English communication skills, broaden their global perspectives and strengthen their personal competitiveness, the school is planning to organise a “Language across the Curriculum Study Tour to Malaysia”. The tour aims to enable students to apply what they have learnt through site visits and cross-disciplinary learning activities.

Preliminary arrangements are as follows:

Dates:	3–6 July 2026 (4 days)
Target Group:	Secondary 1 to Secondary 5 students (20 places)
Activities:	Participation in local English or cross-curricular lessons; visits to Batu Caves, Kwai Chai Hong, TRX Exchange 106, Central Market, and the Petronas Twin Towers.
Fee:	Fees: * Standard: approx. HK\$7,000. Half-grant (School Textbook Assistance Scheme): approx. HK\$5,500. Full-grant or CSSA recipients: approx. HK\$3,500. Note: Fees include meals, accommodation, transport, entry fees, departure tax, and travel insurance.
Selection Criteria:	Written test performance, interview performance, conduct and teacher recommendations.

To assess the feasibility of this study tour, the school is collecting parents' opinions through a survey. Depending on the results, the school intends to begin the selection process in March. 4. Secondary 6 – HKDSE Preparation Arrangements

a. Post-mock Practices

To help Secondary 6 students prepare for the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSE), the school will arrange “Post-mock Practices” from **6–27 February 2026**. Details are as follows:

Remarks:	Students must wear full school uniform

b. S6 Supplementary Lessons

Secondary 6 students must attend supplementary lessons at the times assigned by their teachers and leave school punctually afterwards. Students may enter the school only **10 minutes before** the lesson begins. All students must register at the school entrance upon entering or leaving. Students must follow all school regulations, including:

1. wearing full school uniform (PE uniform is strictly prohibited),
2. not using mobile phones or earphones,
3. not eating or drinking in classrooms.

Students with more than one supplementary lesson on the same day must revise in the Self-study Room (Room 2) while waiting.
